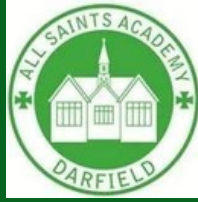

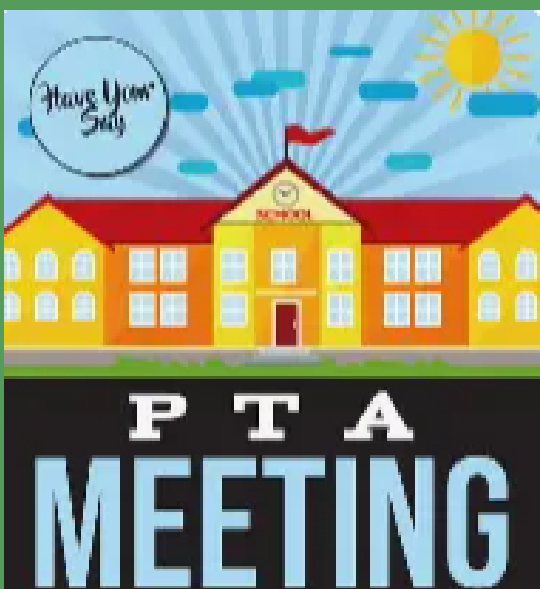

- Working with schools and professionals
- Meeting like-minded parents and realising you are not alone
