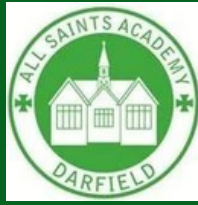

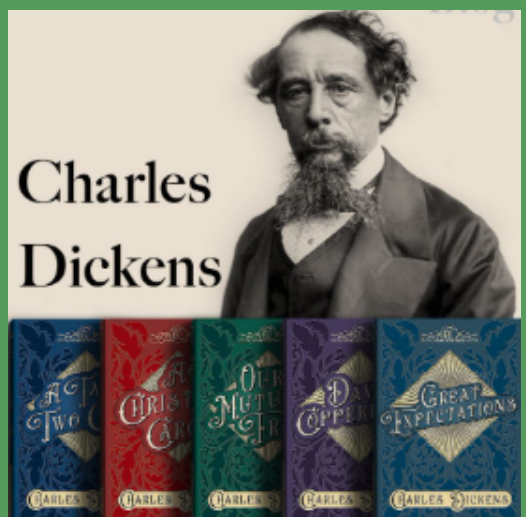

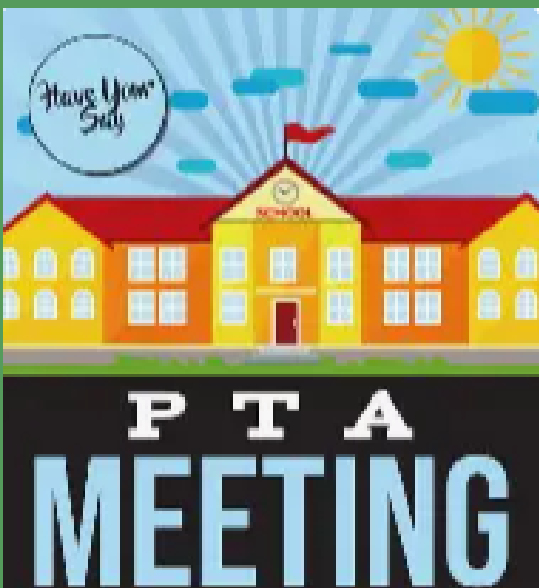


### A Magical Nature Adventure with Katie Taylor

- Meeting like-minded parents and realising you are not alone
