Vocabulary

Holocaust: The Holocaust was the systematic, bureaucratic, state-sponsored persecution and murder of six million Jews by the Nazi regime and its collaborators

Nazi: a member of the National Socialist German Workers' Party

Gestapo officer: the official secret police of Nazi Germany and German-occupied Europe.

allies: a state formally cooperating with another for a military or other purpose

axis: the alignment of nations that fought in the Second World War against the Allied forces

prejudice: a preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience

Neville Chamberlain: when the UK declared war on Germany on 3 September 1939, Chamberlain led Britain through the first eight months of the Second World War.

Sir Winston Churchill: the prime minister of the United Kingdom from 1940 to 1945, when he led Britain to victory in the Second World War.
