	Homework Activities	Date completed
1	Create a video/take photos of you on a nature walk. Take photos of animals and plants that you find. Can you find any evidence of an animal habitat? (email me your videos and photos– to your dojo)	
2	Create a habitat for a made-up animal. You should think about what it needs to survive.	
3	Create your own animal food chain. Find information about each of the stages.	
4	Make an information booklet about your favourite animal.	
5	Design your own 3D habitat. Which animals would live there?	
6	Find 3 different animals from different habitats and explain how they have adapted to their environment. Eg: A Polar Bear has thick fur to keep it warm.	

Maths

Please practice the 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables every week with your child. The children should be able to:

Say the tables in order - $1 \times 2 = 2$, $2 \times 2 = 4$ etc

Answer quickly out of order - "What is 3×4 ?" "What is 3×9 ?"

Know the inverse number sentence - $5 \times 8 = 40$ inverse $40 \div 8 = 5$

Your child has been given a log on to **Timetables Rockstar** to help them practice.

We also play **Hit the Button** - An interactive game where the children have to answer the timetables in a given amount of time.

Spelling
